

Gift Aid Declaration

Gift aid currently amounts to 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate. If you are a UK taxpayer, Gift aid is reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year.

All you need to do is complete this Gift Aid declaration form and send it to admin@pregnancycentresnetwork.org.uk, or post it to:
